



IOSH Working Safely



IOSH Working Safely is a one-day course designed to give all employees a better understanding of the importance of safety in the work place. It is highly interactive and gives delegates a good, all round understanding of their duties as employees, hazard spotting, developing control measures and how they can contribute to the organisation's safety performance.

Who will benefit?

Working Safely is a one-day course. It is non-industry specific and is suitable for any employee and assumes little, or no prior training in health and safety.

Course Content

Module 1 – Introducing working safely

Why employees should work safely from a legal, moral and economic point of view.

Module 2 – Defining hazard and risk

Delegates will carry out a hazard spotting exercise and relate this to their own workplace. As part of the exercise the risks will be rated and control measures identified and introduced.

Module 3 – Identifying common hazards

Identifying hazards that exist in the workplace

Module 4 – Improving safety performance

Looking at how the company can improve its safety performance through organisational arrangements that form their safety management system.

Module 5 – Protecting our environment

Provides an introduction to waste and pollution. It explores ways in which companies and individuals can reduce pollution by cutting down on waste.

Certification

Delegates who attend the course and successfully complete the written and practical assessments, will receive either an IOSH Working Safely Certificate or Health and Safety Passport Card.
